Edward Valentine Tulowiecki, 87, of Liverpool, NY passed away on Wednesday at the Home of the Good Shepard in Saratoga Springs, NY.

Ed was born February 27, 1934 in Syracuse and is a graduate of Eastwood High School. He was the youngest child of Alexander and Eleanora Tulowiecki, immigrants who came from Poland in search of the American dream.
