Frederick G. Rogusz passed away Saturday, May 9, 2015. A native of Syracuse, he attended Sacred Heart school and Cathedral Academy. He retired as a Supervisor from the Solvay Post Office in 1992, after 30 years of service. Prior to that he worked at General Electric Company for 15 years.

Mr. Rogusz was a communicant of the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and a member of its Holy Name Society. He was also former President and Tour Director of the Sacred Heart Seniors, as well as a former member and President of the church choir for 23 years.

Mr. Rogusz proudly served his country as a member of the U.S. Navy during the Korean Conflict. He was also a member of the Polish-American Veterans Post #1, former Commander of the Polish Legion of American Veterans Post #14, the Polish Heritage Club, Polish National Alliance of America, the Polish Community Home and its Board of Directors.

An avid horseman, he was a member of the Empire State Quarter Horse Association leaving behind his sidekick, Cody.
