John Robert Hannon, 94, of Syracuse, died at his home on Friday. Born in Syracuse, John served with the US Marines in the South Pacific theater, including Guadalcanal. He returned home to join the Syracuse Police Department, retiring in 1983 after 32 years of service. He was a flight instructor and commercial pilot, a member of the P.B.A. retirees and a Communicant of St. Stephen's and the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. He was predeceased by his wife, Christina Catherine, in 1986.

Surviving are his five daughters: Linda (Richard) Fritz of Niskayuna, Kathleen Sowan of Raleigh, NC, Patricia Ann Hannon of Syracuse, Anna Marie Monica of Rome and Colleen Senke of Syracuse; twelve grandchildren; three great-grandchildren and three great-great grandchildren.
