Mary Klimaszewski Bobowski, formerly of Westvale, was born in Syracuse, 25 March 1921. She graduated from Sacred Heart School, Central High School and Crouse-Irving Memorial School of Nursing. Mary proudly served her country during WWII as a 2nd Lieutenant in the U.S. Army Nurse Corps. After the war, she was on staff as a registered nurse at Columbia-Presbyterian Hospital in New York City, as a charge nurse at St. Josephs Hospital and as a office nurse for her brother, Dr. Lucyan F. Kilimas. A life well lived.

Mary is predeceased by her brothers, Dr. Lucyan F. Klimas in 1961 and Dr. Mitchell M. Klimaszewski in 1965, and her husband Karol Bobowski in 2004. She was a Life Communicant at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

She is survived by her son, Dr. Casimir K. Bobowski, of Skaneateles, New York, two nephews, Col (Ret.) Thomas Klimas of Garden Ridge, TX and Dr. Richard Klimas of Huntsville, Alabama. Also, by many friends, supporters and care givers.
