Stanley J. Wadach of Syracuse passed away on October 8th 2014. Born in New York Mills, New York, he lived most of his life in the Central New York area. He was a graduate of Syracuse University with a Bachelor of Science Degree. He had over 34 years of Federal Government service as a tax examiner with the U.S. Treasury Department Internal Revenue Service. He was the District Director's Representative for the Syracuse region for over 16 years and retired in 1981. He was a member of many local organizations and served as an officer for several. He was a little league football and baseball coach in the Westvale area for a number of years. A veteran of World War II, he was a Bombardier-Navigator and flew over 30 missions on B-29 Super Fortresses with the 20th Air Force stationed in Saipan. He was awarded an Air Medal with several Bronze Clusters, a Distinguished Flying Cross and many other commendations for service in the Asiatic-Pacific War theater.

Survivors are his wife, Melanie, of 66 years; daughters Melanie L. Kelly (John) and Marilyn J. O'Connor (Thomas); sons Mark E. Wadach (Maureen) and Mathew J. Wadach (Barbara); 13 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.

There will be no calling hours. Funeral services will be held at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart of Jesus at 10 am on Monday, October 13th, and internment at the Onondaga County Veterans Memorial Cemetery.
